25 July Social Media Post after the Fires in Türkiye and Cyprus

Wildfires that are becoming more frequent, larger, and harder to control across the world are not just natural disasters; they are devastating consequences of climate change. Each fire threatens not only trees but also biodiversity, ecosystem services, and human life. In recent weeks, wildfires in İzmir and its surroundings inflicted severe ecological and social damage on the region.

Thousands of hectares of forested land were destroyed.

*Wildlife suffered greatly; many animals lost their habitats.

윢 Some settlements were evacuated, and agricultural lands were damaged.

Firefighting efforts lasted for days, with hundreds of personnel and dozens of air and ground vehicles mobilized.

Afterwards, a wildfire in Eskişehir spread rapidly with strong winds, turning a vast area into ashes.

Approximately 1,500 hectares were damaged.

🗎 Some homes, barns, and farmlands were completely burned; many livestock perished.

V Lives were lost.

And finally, the largest fire disaster in Cyprus's history reduced the Limassol mountains to ashes.

♣ 12,000 hectares — equivalent to about 16,800 football fields — of forested land were destroyed.

Two people lost their lives, 26 were injured, two of them critically.

But what was lost was not only the trees:

Pines, olives, carobs, and maquis burned down.

Wild animals perished in the flames.

Tendemic plant species disappeared.

Migratory birds lost their routes.

All these disasters once again reveal the destructive effects of climate change, drought, and human negligence on nature. Experts warn that the ecological damage will last for 120 years, perhaps even longer.

As our forests burn, we are losing not only trees but also our future. The time has come — and is running out — to take collective and determined action for nature. Beyond intervention, preventive and sustainable policies are essential.

• Without fighting the climate crisis, we cannot stop forest fires.

To protect nature is to protect the future.

Dünya genelinde sıklaşan, büyüyen ve kontrolü zorlaşan orman yangınları, sadece doğal felaketler değil; iklim değişikliğinin yıkıcı sonuçlarıdır. Her yangın, sadece ağaçları değil; biyoçeşitliliği, ekosistem hizmetlerini ve insan yaşamını tehdit etmektedir.

Geçtiğimiz haftalarda İzmir ve çevresinde çıkan orman yangınları bölgeye ağır bir ekolojik ve toplumsal zarar verdi.

🌳 Binlerce hektarlık ormanlık alan yok oldu.

🐾 Doğal yaşam büyük darbe aldı; yaban hayvanları yaşam alanlarını kaybetti.

🗫 Bazı yerleşim yerleri boşaltıldı, tarım alanları zarar gördü.

Syangınlara müdahale günlerce sürdü; yüzlerce personel, onlarca hava ve kara aracı seferber edildi.

Ardından, Eskişehir'de çıkan orman yangını, şiddetli rüzgarın etkisiyle hızla yayılarak büyük bir alanı küle çevirdi.

Yangın sonucu yaklaşık 1.500 hektar alan zarar gördü.

Razı evler, ahırlar ve tarım alanları tamamen yandı; çok sayıda büyükbaş ve küçükbaş hayvan telef oldu.

insanlarımız öldü.

Ve son olarak, Kıbrıs tarihinin en büyük yangın felaketi Limasol dağlarını küle çevirdi.

👫12 bin hektar — yani yaklaşık 16.800 futbol sahası büyüklüğünde ormanlık alan yok oldu.

🅰 Yangında iki insan yaşamını yitirdi, 26 kişi yaralandı, ikisi ağır.

Ancak kaybedilen yalnızca ağaçlar değildi:

🦰 Çamlar, zeytinler, harnuplar ve makilerle birlikte,

Doğadaki hayvanlar yanarak can verdi,

ᢝ Endemik bitki türleri yok oldu,

Göçmen kuşlar yönlerini kaybetti.

Tüm bu felaketler, bir kez daha iklim değişikliği, kuraklık ve insan kaynaklı ihmallerin doğa üzerindeki yıkıcı etkilerini gözler önüne seriyor. Uzmanlara göre, tüm bu büyük ekolojik yıkımların etkileri 120 yıl, belki de daha uzun sürecek.

Ormanlarımız yanarken sadece ağaçları değil, geleceğimizi de kaybediyoruz. Doğa için ortak ve kararlı adımlar atma zamanı geldi, geçiyor. Yangınlara karşı sadece müdahale değil, önleyici ve sürdürülebilir politikalar şart.






World Habitat Day 2024 and World Architecture Day 2024

Every October, UN-Habitat (UN-HABITAT) and its partners organize a month of events and discussions on urban sustainability. The events, which start with World Habitat (Human Settlements) Day on the first Monday of October every year, and end with World Cities Day on October 31, are called Urban October. Urban October is an opportunity for everyone to be part of the conversation about the challenges and opportunities created by rapid change in our cities and towns. Every October, under the Urban October, anyone interested in sustainable urbanization, from national and local governments to universities, NGOs, and communities, are encouraged to organize or participate in virtual and/or physical events and discussions. World Habitat Day, established by the United Nations General Assembly in 1985 with Resolution 40/202 and was first celebrated in 1986, also corresponds with World Architecture Day. Its purpose is to reflect on the state of our cities and the fundamental right of everyone to adequate shelter. At the same time, World Habitat Day aims to remind the world that we have the power and responsibility to shape the future of our cities and towns and which is celebrated on the first Monday of October every year.

This year, in 2024, World Habitat Day (WHD 2024) and World Architecture Day 2024, we prepared informative awareness posters for social media in English. Also, Director of URDC had a press message on a local newspaper for these special days.






